1. Marching Band

Marching Band is a very important and vital element of the band program. During this portion of the year, the band is viewed and heard by more individuals than at any other time of the year. A successful marching season sets the tone for the entire year; therefore, every effort must be made by all to insure the success of the marching band. Dedication and maximum effort in all aspects of marching, playing and performance are expected.

All students in the band program are required to participate in all aspects of the marching band. The following practice schedule will be used throughout most of our marching season. Notification will be provided to students when this schedule is modified.

Monday: 3:45 - 6:15 PM
Tuesday: 3:45 - 6:15 PM
Wednesday: 3:30 - 4:30 PM
Thursday: 3:45 - 5:45 PM

2. Wind Ensemble / Symphonic Band / Concert Band

Membership in the Wind Ensemble, Symphonic Band, or Concert Band is based on audition. Students should exhibit their highest level of musicianship, responsibility, and academics. Students should show qualities of <u>dedication</u>, <u>responsibility</u>, and <u>commitment</u> regardless of band placement.

All bands are required to participate in all aspects of the marching band, concerts, and UIL performances. Notification to students will be given for additional required practices, sectionals, or performances.

Band Competitions

All eligible students are required to be at all competitions:

- Marching Contests
- UIL Solo/Ens. Contest
- UIL Concert and Sight-Reading (Wind Ensemble / Symphonic)
- possible additional functions may be added

- 1. Varsity Football Games
- 2. Marching Contests
- 3. Solo and Ensemble Contest
- 4. UIL Concert / SR Contest
- 5. Concerts
- 6. Other performances that may be scheduled during the year.*

Football Procedures

Football Games

Students will meet at a designated time in the hall to prepare for football games. Once all students are prepared and equipment loaded, students will then be transported to and from the football game regardless of being home or away. Upon returning to the band hall, students will return their uniform to the uniform room. Student will be dismissed once the band hall is clean, equipment is placed in the proper places, and all uniform parts are returned.

Parent/Guardian Expectations

Please be available, or make arrangements, to pick your child up after an event/practice at the appropriate time. The directors and student leadership team is required to stay until every student has a ride home. All students should be off campus within 30 minutes after an event or practice concludes. Please communicate with us, using email or remind, in advance if there is an issue picking up your child within 30 minutes after the conclusion of an event or practice.

Grading Policy

Band Letter Jacket Requirements

If the fourth year is not completed, the jacket must be returned to the director. Their school obligation will not be considered cleared until the jacket is returned. It is the student's responsibility to confirm the earned points with a director.
